MEDICO-LEGAL EXPERIENCE (including % for Plaintiff and Defendant): I have provided expert opinion since 1997, and currently prepare 50 reports per year. I have appeared in Court on two occasions. The ratio of opinion I have given on behalf of claimants to defendant is about 9:1.	
SPECIAL SKILLS: I have more than 30 years experience in Obstetrics and Gynaecology, including 21 years as a Consultant. My main area of expertise is in the area of consent for surgery, operative complications, minimal access surgery (laparoscopy and hysteroscopy), hysterectomy and myomectomy. I have been a member of a number of Working Groups, Advisory Panels and Sub-Committees advising the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists on aspects of minimal access and endoscopic surgery. I have been running postgraduate training courses on endoscopic and vaginal surgery since 1989. I have had more than 230 publications in peer reviewed scientific journals and books, a large proportion on endoscopic surgery and hysterectomy. I have written the chapter on "Hysteroscopy and Laparoscopy" published in the last two editions of a standard postgraduate UK textbook, Dewhurst's Textbook of Obstetrics and Gynaecology. I have made over 380 presentations and national and international scientific meetings.
